

IOSH Managing Safely Course

Course Outline

This course is designed by Sussex Safety to give managers and supervisors the knowledge to understand their health and safety responsibilities, and reduce risks to staff, clients and their organisation. The course can be tailored to the policies of your organisation, so delegates become familiar with your documentation. Tutors are experienced health and safety risk managers and share real life situations and experiences, which gives insight to improve safety management systems. Delegates are encouraged to write an action plan during the course to take back to their workplace. - Define 'hazard' and 'risk' and describe legal requirements for risk assessments.
- Have a practical understanding of risk assessment using your organisation's forms.
- Understand the risks associated with hazards, and develop knowledge in their prevention and control.
- Understand the importance of active and reactive monitoring, auditing and implementation methods.
- Understand the principles of accident prevention, investigation and reporting.
- Appreciate the importance of communicating the health and safety message.

Assessments and Certification

- Theory assessment - a short written assessment paper, consisting of 25 multiple-choice or short answer questions.
- Practical workplace project - based on the application of knowledge gained on the course. It is completed during the course, and is submitted on the last day.

An ***IOSH Managing Safely*** certificate is awarded to all those who successfully complete the written and practical assessments.

Course Options

In-house
