

# IOSH Safety for Executives and Directors

### Course Outline

This is an interactive tailored course which communicates the importance of health and safety to people at the most senior levels in an organisation. It will enable senior management to review policies and strategies and, where necessary, introduce changes to reduce risks. If requested, in-house courses are tailored to the policies of the organisation, and we are keen to work with the health and safety manager both prior and during the session. The course facilitators are experienced risk managers and are up to date with current practice. This course is highly respected, valued and recognised as best practice by the Health and Safety Executive. This course replaces the IOSH Safety for Senior Executives course.

### Learning Objectives

- Understand health and safety as a main line management function, emanating from the top and descending through management layers.
- Recognise the financial implications of accidents and ill-health caused by working conditions.
- Understand the penalties for offences relating to health and safety legislation, including corporate manslaughter and fee for intervention.
- Understand current legislation, particularly the Health and Safety at Work Act and the Management of Health and Safety at Work Regulations.
- Understand the requirement for documentation to reduce risks and comply with legislation.
- Understand the principles of accident causation and prevention.
- Describe the basic principles of risk management.
