

IOSH Working Safely

Course Outline

This is a highly interactive course using high quality graphics to assist learning. This 1 day course is designed to be fun and to get delegates fully involved and interested. It is jargon free, teaching only what they need to know in practice. It focuses on best practice rather than legislation, and provides employees with an awareness of their own safety, as well as the safety of others. The assessments are built into the day.

Learning Outcomes

On successful completion of the course, delegates should be able to:

- Understand why they must work safely.
- Understand the difference between hazards and risks.
- Identify hazards.
- Appreciate and improve upon safety performance within the workplace.
- Appreciate how to protect the environment.

Who should attend

Anyone needing a grounding in the essentials of health and safety, or those needing a passport to work on a construction site. The course is recognised as equivalent to a Level 1 Award in Health and Safety in a Construction Environment. So delegates who successfully complete the course can apply for a Construction Skills Certification Scheme (CSCS) green labourer's card, once they have passed the CITB Health, Safety and Environment Operatives Test.

Assessment and Certification

The assessments consist of 10 multiple choice questions and 3 hazard spotting exercises. Successful delegates are awarded the IOSH Working Safely Certificate or credit card size IOSH Passport. (The organisation is responsible for providing the photograph for the passport and National Insurance number of Staff number for each delegate).

Course Options

In-house

Venue: requirements in your workplace include: seating with tables; a wall/screen on which to show a laptop presentation; flip chart; and facilities where staff can access refreshments.

Duration: 1 day

No. of Delegates: up to 16
